### **Removal of mobile aerial equipment**

Southwark Council is committed to improving mobile connectivity for residents across the borough. To maintain this commitment, we are working with a mobile network operator to remove their existing aerial equipment on the roof of your building.

Works are planned between **27<sup>th</sup> July – 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021**, during the hours of **08:00 and 17:00**. On estate parking bays will be suspended on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> July.

A crane will be used on 29th July, which will require the closure of Western Street (as seen below) from 7:00 to 17:00. On street parking bays will be unavailable on these dates.

We have asked contractors to consider residents privacy and keep noise and disruption to a minimum.



The council have taken measures to ensure the work conducted is completed in a safe and timely manner. The equipment is confined to the rooftop, and is fully compliant with international safety standards.
